<p>Date</p>	<p>3rd February to 7th February, 2018 Participants are expected to arrive on 2nd~3rd February 2018 and may depart on 7th~8th February.</p> <p>It is suggested that participants to arrive the conference venue one day before. It takes about 2 hours from Taoyuan International Airport (TPE) to the venue (Fo Guang University).</p> <p>(Please notice that if participants decide to arrive early on 2nd February and/or leave on 8th February, it will cost an extra fee for the accommodation and meals. Participants may also choose to stay in hostels rather than the conference venue.)</p>

<p>Eligibility of participant:</p>	<p>Participants from NSOs must be endorsed by the National Scout Organization and must be between 18 to 26 years old on the date of the conference.</p>
<p>Language</p>	<p>Mandarin Chinese Most of the sessions of 2018 National Rover Conference will be conducted in Mandarin Chinese; therefore, participants who know Mandarin are more preferable.</p>
<p>Conference Registration Fee</p>	<p><u>NT3500 (USD110) Dollars per participant (pay on arrival)</u></p>




	<p>The fee covers conference kit and materials, inland transportation, and accommodation for four nights (check-in on 3rd February 2018 and check-out on 7th February 2018), meals for five days (starting from dinner of 3rd February till lunch of 7th February 2018).</p> <p>Participants will live in dormitory, please prepare your own sleeping bag and sleeping pad.</p>

➤ **Further information for visiting Taiwan:**

<p>Arrive by Airplane</p>	<p>The main international airport of Taiwan is Taiwan Taoyuan international airport (TPE), there are some other options such as Taipei Songshan Airport (TSA) and Hualien Airport (HUN), however we strongly recommend that participants to be arrived at Taiwan Taoyuan international airport (TPE) on 2nd~3rd February.</p>
<p>VISA</p>	<p>Citizens of some countries will require valid visa to enter Taiwan (R.O.C). Thus, all participants should obtain an entry visa before traveling to Taiwan (R.O.C.) and can consult their local travel advice service or the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in most capital cities. For information about the latter visit the webpage of the Taiwan Ministry of Foreign Affairs: http://www.mofa.gov.tw/.</p> <p>All those requiring an invitation letter or other assistance should contact us with email before January 10th, 2018.</p>
<p>Venue Location</p>	<p>2018 National Rover Conference will be held in Fo Guang University, Yilan County, located in northern part of Taiwan.</p> 



<p>Weather in Yilan</p>	<p>In Taiwan, winter is from November to February. Temperatures hit 15/16°C (59/60°F), and there are some rainy days during the period of time, also it might get very windy so a jacket or a cardigan and an umbrella may be necessary</p>
<p>Voltage</p>	<p>Electric current of 110 volts at 60 cycles is used in Taiwan, participants from Europe, Australia or South-East Asia will need an adaptor or transformer. Many buildings have sockets with 220 volts especially for the use of air conditioners.</p>  <p>*The plugs used in Taiwan.</p>
<p>Currency</p>	<p>The Republic of China's (Taiwanese) unit of currency is the New Taiwan Dollar (NT\$), which has five denominations in paper money and five in coins. Paper money comes in NT\$2000, NT\$1000, NT\$500, NT\$200, and NT\$100 denominations. Coins come in NT\$50, NT\$20, NT\$10, NT\$5 and NT\$1 denominations.</p> <p>Our currency rankings show that the most popular Taiwan New Dollar exchange rate is the USD to TWD rate, and the rate is around \$1US dollar to NT\$30 dollars.</p> <p>Major credit cards such as American Express, Master Card, Visa, and Diners Club are accepted and traveler's checks may be cashed at foreign-exchange banks, some tourist-oriented businesses, and most international tourist hotels.</p>
<p>Time</p>	<p>Taiwan Standard Time, UTC +8 hours.</p>
<p>Mobile Phones</p>	<p>GSM mobile phones operate in the 900 MHz or 1800 MHz frequency bands.</p>
